- 9. Describe the way you perceive leadership and the role of a leader.
- 10. Are you currently engaged in a mentoring relationship as either a mentor or mentee? (Who do you mentor? What level are they at?)
- 11. Please describe your perceived strengths and weaknesses as a leader. (How do you feel the program will help you address these issues?)
- 12. What career aspirations do you hold for the future and how do you perceive the program will assist you to achieve these aspirations?
